

The genealogy files of Ann Arnold Hennings (1937-2020) contained a communication from Clarence Alfred Ritter (1928-2014), grandson of Anna (Caylor) Ritter (1872-1939). As best I can guess, the photocopies that Clarence sent Ann were received about 2000, and were of relatively poor quality. However, the material contained an image of Hiram Avra Caylor (1887-1942), an image of the supposed home of Hiram's father, Thomas Edward Caylor (1860-1929), as well as images of postcards sent from various family members to Hiram, circa 1911.



I've scanned all the photocopies and cleaned up the brightness and contrast to improve, somewhat, the quality of the images. They are all contained in this .pdf file.

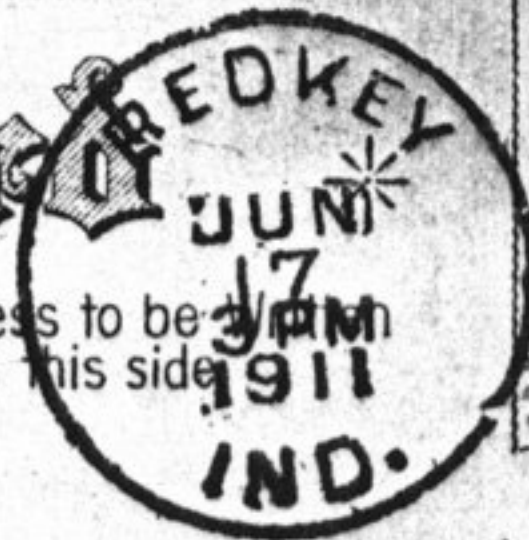

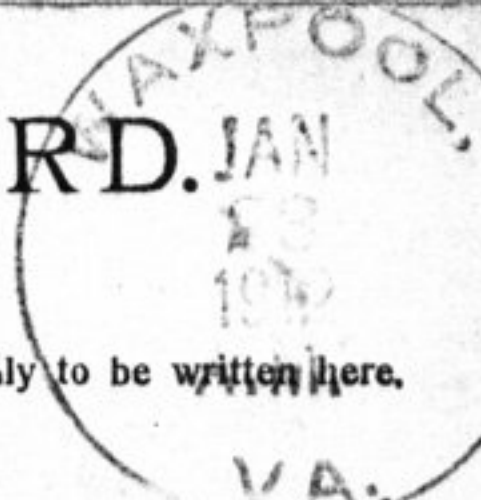
