RESEARCH OBJECTIVE

Collect all evidence to show the parentage of Nicholas Caylor.

ITEMIZED RESEARCH RESULTS

This is a listing of all documented evidence of Nicolas Caylor in Loudon County (or anywhere else as of this date – Nov 2007). However, one group of records that I've not yet examined is the court orders from Loudoun County.

Notes:

Does not appear in deed books 1800-1810.

Does not appear in Loudoun militia records which start in 1793.

Does not appear in Loudoun land tax records that begin in 1782.

Personal property taxes were assessed in the period Mar-Jun of the tax year although some returns were not made until later in the fall.

Does not appear in any marriage record or death record.

10	1792	Nicolas Caylor appeared in the Loudoun County 2 nd Battalion personal property tax lists in the household of Barbara Caylor as a male tithable over 16. ¹⁰	
11	11 Feb 1793	The Loudoun Court ordered an inventory and appraisal of the estate of Nicholas Cailer. The appraisal totaled £79.12.11 and the appraisers were John Pancost, Godfrey Kipheart and William Snidor. The document was recorded 9 Sep 1793. ¹¹	The record contains no suggestion of a wife.

ANALYSIS OF ITEMIZED RESULTS

Based on the tithable listing, Nicholas was age 16 between Jun 1780 and Jun 1781 when the assessments were made. This places his birth between Jun 1764 – Jun 1765. His death occurred after Jun 1792 and before 11 Feb 1793 at about age 27.

His mother was Barbary Calor – see research report on Barbary for more information.
