Rites Arranged For Church, Lodge Figure

BOISE, June 27.—(AP)—Funeral services for the Rev. Howard Stoy, 69, archdeacon of the Idaho Episcopal church since 1908, who died last night, will be held Friday in St. Michael's cathedral here, with Bishop M. S. Barmwell officiating.

A native of New Jersey, the Rev. Mr. Stoy had been a resident of Idaho for the past 32 years. He was active in Masonic lodges and had been a prelate of Pocatello Knights Templar 22 years.

His early life was spent as an instructor in the Episcopal schools and later he became rector of Episcopal churches in McCook, Neb., Rawlins, Wyo., and Hailey, Idaho.
