give and grant unto the said Philip Stoy his  
heirs & assigns from the day of the date hereof: until  
the twenty fifth day of March, which will be in  
the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & thirty one  
(1831) To cut, cart, and haul off the said pro-  
mises, all the timber and wood standing and
