In the name of god amen

I Phebe Young of the county of Washington & State of Tennessee being in perfect sences calling to mind the uncertainty of life and certainty of death I make This my last will and testament in the following manner viz, I give & bequeath unto my four youngest Children that is to say Joseph Phebe Robert & Anny four of the choicest of the cows of the Stock now belonging to me. I also give & bequeath to daughters Phebe & Anna each of them one feather bed & furniture & each one a spinning wheel – I also give & bequeath unto Joseph & Robert my sons all the plantation tools I allow also the ballance of the stock to be [?] or as much as will satisfy the debts & the rest of the property to be divided between Polly Jemima Jenny & betsy Signed Sealed & acknowledged in the presence of us this 26th of February 1810

I Phebe Young of the County of Washington & State of Tennessee being in perfect health calling to mind the uncertainty of life and certainty of death I make this my last will and testament in the following manner (Viz), I give & bequeath unto my four youngest children that is to say Joseph Phebe Robert & Anna four of the Choise of the Cows of the stock now belonging to me. I also give & bequeath to daughter Phebe & Anna each of them one feather bed & furniture & each one a spinning wheel - I also give & bequeath unto Joseph & Robert my sons all the plantation tools I allow also the balance of the stock to be divided or as much as will satisfy the debts & the rest of the property to be divided between Polly Emma Jenny & betsey Segma Seaba & Cinknowledge in the presence of us this 10th of February 1810
