Last Will and Testament of Theodore F Stoy

Deceased

Order for Probate

In the name of God, Amen. I, Theodore F. Stoy of the township of Delaware, in the county of Camden and state of New Jersey, being of sound mind, memory and understanding for which blessing I thank God, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say -

First: I do hereby order and direct and it is my will that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

Second - I do hereby demise, will and bequeath all of the property and estate that I am possessed of, or that I may hereafter become possessed of, whether real, personal or mixed, to my wife, Ella C. Stoy, for her sole and separate use, with authority for her to sell, bequeath, or otherwise dispose of at her own discretion.

Lastly - I do nominate, constitute and appoint my friend Charles E. Hendrickson, sole executor of this my last will and Testament.

In testimony whereof I the said Theodore F Stoy have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight.
